Course Description:

Hosted by Native Village of Point Hope and FEMA Region X. This course combines four separate courses taught in an interactive classroom environment. As an alternative to this classroom based offering, these courses can be completed online on the Emergency Management Institute's Independent Study Website; [ICS-100: Introduction to ICS](#), [ICS-200: ICS for Single Resources and Initial Action Incidents](#), [IS-700: An Introduction to NIMS](#), and [IS-800: An Introduction to the National Response Framework \(NRF\)](#). These courses cover the basic requirements needed for the more advanced G-191, ICS-300, and ICS-400 courses.

Note: Students will be required to successfully complete four online exams in class in order to receive credit for each of the courses covered.

Target Audience:

Federal, state, tribal, and local emergency management and response personnel who require ICS and NIMS training within their organization. This typically includes those responsible or involved in emergency planning, response, and/or recovery efforts.

Funding:

Tuition is free for those accepted; there are no travel/salary stipends available for this offering and all incurred costs are the responsibility of the attendee or sending organization.

Prerequisites:

There are no prerequisites for this course.

Participants will need a Student Identification (SID). If you do not yet have a SID, just follow these three simple steps to obtain one:
